

The 10k course is certified by the Road Runners Club of America and takes runners through the Laramie tree area, past several of the local parks. Start and finish is at beautiful Undine Park in Laramie. Following the race, runners may relax and be served breakfast. Because everybody already has too many t-shirts, runners receive a running hat instead. This race is a High Plains Harriers race, and members of this running club receive a \$5 discount for registration.
